About the Workshop

In this workshop you will be encouraged to look at watercolour in a different way by letting this medium speak for itself. You will explore the many facets of watercolour; painting trees and landscapes from woodland images using unconventional methods. Watercolour can be very scary because it has a mind of its own, but you will learn to work with this to produce interesting results.

This course is suitable for all abilities, even those who have never picked up a brush have produced great results.

Morning

- Sue will perform a watercolour demonstration to the group
- Loosening up exercises
- Looking for a pleasing composition
- Making small impressions
- Learning how to effectively crop your work

Afternoon

- Break for lunch
- Looking back at the work produced in the morning session
- Turning small studies into larger work
- Tightening up and exploring knowing when to stop
- Review: there will be a chance to view each other's work and an opportunity to ask questions.

About the Tutor

Sue Howells is self-taught and started painting in the late 90s. She is a member of several prestigious societies and has enjoyed great success, winning the Soloman and Whitehead Award in 2008, followed in the same year by being recognised by the Fine Art Trade Guild of Great Britain as the bestselling published artist in the UK.

Materials

- Paper: 140 lb Arches or Saunders NOT Hot Pressed
- A selection of watercolour tubes
- A selection of watercolour brushes: large to medium
- A selection of Chinese brushes: large to medium (or just medium is fine)
- Toothbrush
- Sponge
- Palette knife
- Large mixing palette or large dinner plate
- Water container
- Kitchen roll

Sue will bring along a selection of her own photographic images of landscapes and woodlands for reference during the session. Please also bring along your own imagery if preferred.
