## About the Workshop

Explore the basic properties of abstraction through observation of shape, rhythm, space, mark and colour. Using chance and order to challenge the properties of water-based media, RWS artist John Crossley will lead you through the potential of working with cut-outs and stencils as a mechanism to develop ideas.

This workshop is suitable for all levels of ability.

#### Morning

- Introduction
- Observing the surroundings of the riverside, from the minute to the large, to produce studies in water-based media.

#### Afternoon

- Using the studies produced in the morning, participants will expand the ideas in a more finished piece, or series of pieces.
- Conclusion


## About the Tutor


True to the roots of the artist, he originally studied sculpture in the 70's at St. Martins School of Art under Anthony Caro, Phillip King and William Tucker, Crossley's works marry colour with form and space. Unlike many of his contemporaries he is attracted to the resonance of colour as a language of emotional experience. Crossley's paintings are bright clear notes ringing out amid the cacophony of contemporary art, characterised by their exuberant, gleaming colours, his paintings transcend our assumptions about 'Englishness' and beguile us instead with an exotic vibrancy.

- A small cutting mat and scalpel
- Metal ruler
- Paper and pencils (2B upwards)
- Sketchbook
- PVA or pritt stick
- Low tack masking tape
