About the Workshop

Complete a series of small exercises to help you gain confidence using watercolour. With a focus on tone and shape, RWS artist Anne Lynch will guide you through the techniques used to produce a watercolour painting from direct observation of a still life. This workshop is suitable for complete beginners and Anne will provide plenty of support throughout the day. All that is needed is a willingness to explore!

Morning

- Introduction
- Exploration of tone and composition with a series of short exercises using a monochromatic (black and white) palette.

Afternoon

- Development of a larger-scaled painting using the skills practised in the morning session. This can be in monochrome or colour.
- Conclusion

About the Tutor



Materials

- A5 or A6 200gsm watercolour paper
- A4 or A3 300gsm watercolour paper
- Sketchbook (if you prefer to work in these)
- Watercolour set – pans or tubes (if you are undecided, you can just bring black and white)
- Selection of watercolour paint brushes
- Glue stick or pritt stick
- Water container and mixing palette or plate
